EDV-300 Indoor Safety Day Counter



The EDV-300 is an indoor safety day counter that increments or decrements everyday at midnight (00:00). The supplied infrared remote allows for complete control over the display at the push of a button. The display is offered in 3 and 4 digit variations with 3" and 8" options. The 3" model has a viewing distance up to 140 ft; while the 8" model has a viewing distance up to 375 ft. The configuration of the display is only a five step process and takes just a few minutes. The configuration process can be viewed on the next two pages of this document. Due to a recent change to the infrared remote, follow the steps to configure the display based on the remote you received with the display (Process is the same, simply the explanation of the remote is different).

Remote Control information





: Turns Display off



: Enters Edit mode



: The left and right arrows allow switching between digits when in the edit mode.



: Save the edited data in the edit mode.



Counter/timer modes:

▲ : Configures display to count Up.

▼ : Configures display to count down.

Quick Setup

- 1. Press the "**EDIT**" button and input the days (DDD) you would like to count up or count down from and press "**ENTER**."
- 2. Input the current hours (HH) in a 24 hour format and press "ENTER."
- 3. Input the current minutes (MM) and press "ENTER."
- 4. Input the current seconds (SS) and press "ENTER."
- 5. Select whether you would like to count up or down with the Timer buttons (See remote description above for counter/timer modes).
